STATE BANK OF INDIA Vs Vikas Jindal

Accused Vikas Jindal declared PO.

Proclamation issued against accused **Vikas Jindal** has already been received back duly executed. Statement of Serving Constable has been recorded, wherein he has proved proclamation Ex.PX and report as Ex.PY. Period of 30 days has lapsed, since the service of proclamation upon the accused was executed on **14.10.2025**. Despite due publication, accused has not appeared and it is apparent that accused are absconding and concealing himself. Accordingly, accused **Vikas Jindal** is declared proclaimed Offender. In terms of instructions received from the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court vide letter No. 11766 Gazette-II-17 dated 28.4.2015. Intimation in this regard be sent to concerned SHO with a direction to enter the name of the accused in the relevant register maintained as per police rules and with a further direction to arrest the accused and produce him before the court as soon as possible by taking all the necessary steps as per law and with the further direction to register FIR against the accused **Vikas Jindal** under Section 174-A of IPC/209 of BNS and send intimation to this Court with compliance report. The above said instructions be sent to the SHO concerned through the Naib Court. Reader of this Court is directed to forward to the copy of order to the concerned SHO for information and necessary action.

Separate list of particulars of property of accused for the purpose of attachment under Section 83 of Cr.P.C/BNS not filed. Ld. Counsel for the complainant stated that he shall file the particulars of property of accused as and when they come to his knowledge for further proceedings. However, Ahlmad is directed to separate the copy of P.O order and intimation to Manager of concerned bank for attachment of account of accused as mentioned in cheque in question, under intimation to this Court.

File be consigned to record room after due compliance with a red ink note that accused has been declared as proclaimed person in the present case and proceedings against him will be initiated as and when he will be arrested or accused himself appears before the Court and till then file should not be destroyed.
