1. An application for grant of anticipatory bail moved on behalf of accused is pending for disposal.

2. Reply has already been filed.

3. It is jointly submitted that parties have settled the matter by an agreement dated 03.08.2026 and both parties shall abide by the terms and settlement of the agreement. It is further submitted that till date, complainant has received an amount of Rs. 10 Lakh and today, Ld. defence counsel has handed over two cheques of Rs. 20 Lakh dated 27.09.2026 bearing no. 008347 and Rs. 22,75,000/- dated 16.10.2026 bearing no. 008349 respectively both drawn at Union Bank of India, Delhi, as full and final settlement between the parties.(Photocopies of the cheques have been placed on record.)

4. It is further agreed that both cheques shall be honored on their presentation and in case any of the cheque, dishonored, complainant shall be at liberty to file application for cancellation of anticipatory bail and it is jointly prayed that application be allowed.

5. Per contra, the bail application is opposed by Ld. Addl PP for the state.

6. Heard.

7. In view of the submissions made above, and the fact that

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parties have settled the matter, the present application stands allowed and in the event of arrest, accused be released on bail subject to furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs. 30,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of concerned SHO/IO.

8. Accused shall abide by the following conditions:-

i. Accused shall provide permanent address to the Court. Accused shall intimate the Court by way of an affidavit and to the IO regarding any change in residential address.

ii. Accused shall appear before the Court as and when the matter is taken up for hearing unless exempted.

iii. Accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall join the investigation and cooperate in investigation whenever required by the IO. In case any of the cheque, dishonored, complainant shall be at liberty to file application for cancellation of anticipatory bail.

9. Nothing stated herein which shall tantamount to expression of opinion on merits of the case and whatever has been stated is only for the purpose of deciding the application.

10. **Application is disposed of accordingly.**

11. Copy of this order be given dasti to all the parties.
