File taken up today on an application U/s 439 Cr. P. C. for grant of bail to accused Rohit Gupta @ Gulshan to get himself treated for Cancer.

Report of Dy. Superintendent, Central Jail has already been received in this case whereby it has been informed that on the basis of advice received from Rajiv Gandhi Cancer Hospital, a file seeking approval for release of Rs. 6,25,000/- for his treatment has been sent to Prison Head Quarter and surgery would be planned in consultation with Rajiv Gandhi Hospital thereafter. The family members of accused also wants to get the treatment from Rajiv Gandhi Hospital itself. Heard. Perused.

Accordingly, Jail Superintendent is directed to make arrangement for carrying the accused Rohit Gupta to Rajiv Gandhi Hospital under full security on 25.07.2018 in the presence of his family members at 10 am so that relative/family members of accused/patient may discussed with concerned doctor regarding future course of action and if need arises then only they can again approach the Court for bail and if they are satisfied that treatment be provided at State expenses itself as they also want to get the accused treated from same hospital, then there is no need to approach court for bail as approval of funds of Rs. 6,25,000/- has already been sent to Prison Head Quarters. Accused be taken back to jail same day after consultation. Copy of this order be sent to Jail Superintendent for compliance. At this stage, the counsel has submitted that his application be disposed of as withdrawn. Heard.

Accordingly, in view of the submissions of counsel for accused Rohit Gutpa, the present application stands disposed of as withdrawn.

Now to come up on date already fixed in the matter i.e. on 08.08.2018.
