An application for grant of interim bail is pending on record moved on behalf of accused Rohit Gupta for undergoing operation and recovery of mouth cancer.

Report of Medical Superintendent was called. Same has been received whereby it has been intimated that inmate patient was sent to Surgical Oncology Department of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Institute Rotary Cancer AIIMS on 10.12.2018 for possible admission and PAC clearance was done and hospital gave probable date of admission on 27.12.2018 and inmate patient is scheduled for the same. It is further stated that all the prescribed medications are being provided to him from the Jail Dispensary itself. Heard. Perused.

It is observed from report that admission date has already been granted to accused Rohit Gupta for 27.12.2018 and prescribed treatment /medication is being provided to him, hence in these circumstances, the application seeking interim bail stands dismissed.

Meanwhile, report from Medical Superintendent be called for date fixed i.e. 15.01.2019 regarding further treatment given to accused. Family members of accused are permitted to be present in the hospital during operation of accused on scheduled date.

With these observations, the application stands disposed of.
