File taken up today on an application for grant of interim bail filed on behalf of accused Atul Kumar.

Sh. Sat Narain Sharma, counsel for the accused Atul Kumar.

Reply filed. Arguments heard.

It is submitted by the counsel for the accused that accused is having a child aged about two years old on 27.07.2018 and a Gandmool Puja is organized for infant of the accused in Chota Haridwar. It is further submitted that accused is required for the gandmool puja as without him the said puja could not be conducted. It is further submitted that accused was earlier also granted interim bail vide order dated 08.06.2018 and he never misused the same. It is further submitted being the natural guardian, accused is required for the said puja. The invitation card of the Gandmool Puja and birth certificate of the son of the accused are annexed with the application. Considering the facts and circumstances and the fact that accused is the natural guardian of his child, accused Atul Kumar is granted interim bail till 30.07.2018 on furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- with one surety on like amount. The accused shall surrender before the jail superintendent on 31.07.2018. With the

above directions, the application stands disposed of.

To come up on date already fixed i.e. 08.08.2018.
