Matter is listed for arguments on the condonation of delay application.

Arguments on the condonation of delay application heard from both the sides.

Application of the appellant also perused, in respect of the grounds taken by the appellant in the said application seeking condonation of delay.

Vide my separate order pronounced in the open Court, the application for condonation of delay filed by the appellant is allowed subject to cost of Rs. 5,000/- to be paid to the respondent on the next date of hearing.

The appeal has been considered.

On perusal of case file, I find that the present criminal appeal has been preferred against the judgment dated 27.09.2025 whereby accused/appellant has been convicted for the offence punishable under Section 138 NI Act and further sentenced vide order dated 27.10.2025.

An application U/s 430 BNSS has also been filed on behalf of appellant for suspension of sentence till the disposal of the appeal.

Heard.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the sentence awarded by the trial court is suspended and the

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appellant is admitted to bail till the disposal of the appeal on furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of this court. Bail bonds not furnished. **Let the same be furnished by next date of hearing.**

The appellant will deposit 20% of compensation amount within one month from today failing which his suspension of sentence will be revoked.

Put up for further proceedings on 05.09.2026.

Trial Court Record be summoned three days in advance prior to the next date of hearing.

Copy of order be given dasti to appellant.

Copy of this order be also sent to the Ld. Trial Court.
