ORDER ON MAIN PETITION

The petitioner has filed this petition seeking issue directions to the respondent to enter the date of death of father of petitioner No. 1 and 6, father in law of petitioner No. 2, grandfather of petitioner No. 3 to 5, by name Chikkathimmarayappa S/o Late Doddahanumantharayappa who died on **20-04-1978** at Devanahalli, Bengaluru Rural District.

The petition notice to the respondent was duly served. In spite of service of notice, the respondent not appeared before the Court through learned APP and not filed any objections to the main petition. The petitioner No. 1 has been examined as PW-1 and he has got marked the non-availability certificate at Ex.P.1, Geneology tree at Ex.P.2, Notarized copies of adhaar cards of petitioners as Ex.P3 to Ex.P8. Paper publications at Ex.P9 and Ex.P10. The petitioner No. 1 has reiterated the contents of the petition in his examination in chief. There is nothing available on record to disbelieve the version stated by the petitioner on oath. Apart from this, the explanation given by the petitioner No. 1 for non-informing the date of **death** to the concerned authorities is also satisfactory one. The petitioner No. 1 is the

competent person to say regarding the **death** of his father by name Chikkathimmarayappa S/o Late Doddahanumantharayappa . Hence, in my opinion the petitioner has made out grounds to issue directions to the respondents authority as prayed in the petition. Hence, I pass the following.

ORDER

The petition filed by the petitioner is hereby allowed.

The concerned respondent is hereby directed to register the date of death of Chikkathimmarayappa S/o Late Doddahanumantharayappa who died on **20-04-1978** at Devanahalli, Bengaluru Rural District and to issue death certificate to the petitioners accordingly by collecting late fees.
