Report has been received from DCP-I Dwarka District submitting that the FSL result is still not ready and priority letter has been issued to the concerned Director FSL.

Let fresh notice be issued to DCP and SHO concerned to file report regarding the FSL result in the present case and in case the result has not been received, SHO and DCP concerned are directed to issue a fresh priority letter to the concerned Director FSL for expediting the FSL result in the present case, **returnable on NDOH**.

Today Ld Counsel for the accused submits that he is conceding to the charges in the present case.

Heard. Record perused.

In the present case, the statement of eye-witness Sahil Sharma, CCTV footage relied upon by the prosecution, identification of the accused, alleged recovery of clothes, alleged recovery of weapon at the instance of accused Harpreet Singh, post-mortem report of the victim showing homicidal death due to multiple stab injuries and the alleged motive arising out of previous enmity, taken together, prima facie disclose involvement of accused Harpreet Singh in the commission of murder of deceased Rahul.

The material on record also prima facie discloses that the accused was acting along with co-accused / CCL's 'S' and 'P' in furtherance of their common intention. The allegations further show a prior meeting of minds and planning to commit the offence in revenge of an earlier incident. Therefore, prima facie ingredients of criminal conspiracy punishable under Section 61(2)(a) BNS are clearly made out.

CONTD..

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So far as the FSL results qua the CDRs is concerned, the same does not dilute the prima facie case at this stage, as sufficient material already exists on record for framing charge against the accused Harpreet.

Accordingly, there is sufficient prima facie material on record to frame charge against accused Harpreet Singh S/o Gurpreet Singh for the offences punishable under Sections 103(1) read with 3(5) BNS, 2023 and Section 61(2)(a) BNS, 2023.

Charge for the offence punishable **under Sections 103(1) read with 3(5) BNS, 2023 and Section 61(2)(a) BNS, 2023** is framed against the accused Harpreet to which the accused pleaded not guilty and claimed trial.

List the PE on **24.08.2026**.

Let PWs mentioned at **S. No. 2/ Meena Devi, 3/ Parmeshwar and 5/ Laxman** be summoned through IO concerned for NDOH.

Also issue notice to IO and MHCM concerned to produce the case property, if any, on NDOH.

Also issue notice to IO concerned to file supplementary charge sheet, if any in the present case, returnable on NDOH.
