ORDER:-

1. Today, ASI Harjit Singh No.530/Kpt., Police Station City, Kapurthala has appeared alongwith record and suffered statement to the effect that applicants Varun, Karan Deep Sadana and Amit have joined the investigation in the present case on 09.11.2025 and recovery of car

bearing No.PB-09-AP-9670 has been effected from them and they are not required for any further investigation. He further stated that offence punishable under Section 238 BNS was added in the FIR vide DDR No.19 dated 09.11.2025.

2. Ld. defence counsel moved application for adding section 238 BNS stating the Section 238 BNS has been added lateron. It be registered as IA. Record perused. Since, as per statement of ASI Harjit Singh, offence under Section 238 BNS was added in the FIR vide DDR No.19 dated 09.11.2025. The offence has been added after passing of anticipatory interim bail order dated 30.10.2025 and is bailable. The present application stands allowed.

3. Keeping in view the statement of ASI Harjit Singh and the fact that pursuant to order dated 30.10.2025, the accused/applicants have joined the investigation, as such, the order dated 30.10.2025 has been duly complied with. In these circumstances, the interim anticipatory bail granted to accused/applicants vide order dated 30.10.2025 is confirmed subject to the terms and conditions mentioned in the order dated 30.10.2025. However, accused/applicants shall abide by provisions of section 482 (2) BNSS (earlier 438 (2) Cr.P.C.). File be consigned to the Record Room.
