Vide separate statement recorded on 22.07.2026,
Sh. Sanjay Thakur, Advocate for respondent No.3/NHPC has

stated that respondent No.3/NHPC has not preferred any appeal against the award and has no objection, if amount is released in favour of applicants as per their shares.

As per death certificate annexed, Rati Ram (mentioned at Sl. No.3) has expired on 26.09.2019. As per legal heir certificate, following persons are his legal representatives on the strength of registered Will No.55/2019 dated 26.07.2019:-

1. Lotam Ram,
2. Revti Ram
3. Naku Devi

Hence, aforesaid legal heirs are entitled to $1/3^{\text{rd}}$ share each in share of Rati Ram (mentioned at Sl. No.3) i.e. $\text{Rs.}9201 \div 3 = \text{Rs.}3067/-$ each alongwith proportionate interest accrued thereon.

As per death certificate annexed, Revati Ram has also expired on 11.09.2025. As per legal heir certificate, following persons are his legal heirs:-

1. Bhawna Devi,
2. Ayansh Negi (minor)
3. Naku Devi

Hence, aforesaid legal heirs are entitled to $1/3^{\text{rd}}$ share each in share of Revati aforesaid i.e. $\text{Rs.}3067 \div 3 = \text{Rs.}1022.33$ each alongwith proportionate interest accrued thereon.

Heard. Record perused.

By means of this application, applicants have prayed for release of amount lying deposited in the matter, which is required by them to develop their land and to carry out other developmental works on the agricultural and non-agricultural land. Since no requisition has been received from the learned

Appellate Court and in view of no objection of counsel for the respondent No.3/NHPC, application is allowed and the entire amount deposited alongwith upto date interest is ordered to be released in favour of the applicants **except of Aayansh Negi, a minor, as per their shares through their bank accounts**. The share of minor Aayansh Negi be invested in the automatic renewal FDR in his name under lien of this Court till his majority. **The release of shares of Lotam Ram, Naku and Bhawna shall be subject to their furnishing indemnify bond to the tune of ₹5,000/- each undertaking therein to indemnify any other claimants found to have better claim then them on amounts in future.** Application disposed of accordingly. File after due completion be tagged with main case file and main case file be consigned to record room after due completion.
