File taken up today on an application for grant of regular bail moved on behalf of accused Ashu.

Present: Sh. S.K. Berwal, Ld. Sub Addl. PP for the State

IO SI Deepak Vashist is present and he has filed reply. Copy supplied.

1. It is submitted by Ld. counsel for accused that accused is of young age and first time offender and investigation is complete and it is prayed that accused be granted bail.

2. Per contra, the bail application is opposed by Ld. sub Addl PP for the state.

3. The record reveals that the present case was registered on the statement of the complainant Satpal Singh, wherein, he alleged that when he was going from outer ring road to Chander Vihar, some boys came there and stopped him and asked him for Rs. 200/- and also beaten him. During the course of investigation, the present applicant was arrested on 22.10.2024. The investigation is complete and charge sheet has already been filed. Further, as per the IO, the present applicant is stated to be first offender and is not involved in any other criminal case and is of young age of around 21 years. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also keeping in view the age of the applicant and the fact that the applicant is a first offender and is not

involved in any other criminal case and the fact that applicant is languishing in custody since 22.10.2024, **the present application stands allowed**. The applicant is hereby granted bail on furnishing personal bond in sum of Rs.20,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of this court.

4. Further, accused shall abide by the following conditions:

i) Accused shall provide permanent address to the Court. The Accused shall intimate the Court by way of an affidavit and to the IO regarding any change in residential address.

ii) Accused shall appear before the Court as and when the matter is taken up for hearing unless exempted.

iii) Accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not communicate with or come in contact with the complainant/victim or any member of the complainant/victim's family or tamper with the evidence of the case.

5. Nothing stated herein which shall tantamount to expression of opinion on merits of case and whatever has been stated is only for the purpose of deciding the present application. **Application stands disposed of accordingly.**

6. Copy of this order be given dasti to Ld. counsel for applicant / accused, as prayed for. Copy of this order be also sent to Jail Superintendent for information and compliance.
