Mediation proceedings have failed.

Vide order dated 25.05.2026, the application of the appellant for waiver / exemption from depositing the 20% of the compensation amount was dismissed by this court and the appellant was directed to deposit the same within 60 days from the date of said order.

Till date no amount has been deposited by the appellant.

Ld Proxy Counsel for the appellant submits that one week more time be granted to the appellant for depositing the same. Heard. In the interest of justice, one week more time is granted to the appellant for depositing the payment.

List the matter now for depositing the payment by the appellant in terms of order dated 24.01.2026 and 25.05.2026 as well as for arguments on the present appeal on **22.08.2026**.

It is made clear to the appellant that in case he fails to deposit the amount, the suspension of sentence would be revoked and further in case there is failure on part of the appellant to argue / advance submissions on the present appeal, no further opportunity shall be granted to the appellant for raising arguments failing which the appeal would be disposed of on merits on material available on record.
