M/s OBPL (A-1) is represented through its AR Sh. Tarun Kumar Sablania, who has joined the proceedings through VC, but his voice and picture is not coming.

Accused Gautam Thapar (A-2) in person, on bail.

Sh. Rajat Katyal, Sh. Mayank Punia and Sh. Rahul Sambher, Advocates for M/s OBPL (A-1) and Gautam Thapar (A-2).

Accused Rana Kapoor (A-3) not produced from JC from Taloja Jail, Maharashtra.

Sh. Udipto Koushik Sarmah, Advocate for accused Rana Kapoor (A-3).

Ahlmad submits that on telephonic inquiry, HC Anil Lashkar submits that A-3 could not be produced through VC as he has gone to J.J. Hospital. He be apprised about the next date of hearing.

In compliance of order dated 23.02.2023, today accused Gautam Thapar (A-2) has appeared in person alongwith surety for doing the formalities in the bail bond register. The bail bonds of A-2 is finally accepted.

Ld. Counsel appearing for accused persons submit that the complete set of documents could not be checked as the same is voluminous and they need some more time to check the documents and if it is required, they will file an application u/s 207 Cr.P.C for supplying of deficient documents.

IO submits that investigation of the present case has been recently assigned to him and 5-6 month's time is required to complete the same.

Matter now to come up for scrutiny of documents and for further proceedings on 11.12.2023.
