1. These are six separate bail applications filed on behalf of applicants/accused persons namely Anil Bhargava, Tapsi Mahajan, Rajendra Kumar Mangal, Raghbir Kumar Sharma, Abishek S. Pandey and B. Hariharan seeking the grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C.

2. Formal reply to the aforesaid bail applications has already been filed.

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3. Submissions heard. Perused the record.

4. Considering the fact that in the present case, the charge-sheet has been filed against all the applicants/accused persons without arrest. It is also seen that the applicants had duly appeared before the Court when the process were issued to them.

In view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in *Satender Antil vs. Central Bureau of Investigation & Anr., (2021) 10 SCC 773*, the bail applications filed by the applicants are allowed. Accordingly, all the applicants/accused persons are admitted to regular bail on furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount subject to the following conditions :-

- i) They shall not tamper with the evidence;
- ii) They shall not try to contact or influence the witnesses;
- iii) They shall not leave the country without the permission of the Court and shall deposit their passport, if any, with the Court;
- iv) They shall furnish their addresses, mobile number, e-mail ID used by them to the prosecuting agency and shall immediately inform any change in address, mobile number & email ID, if any, to the IO.

On oral request of accused persons, bail bonds, surety bonds be furnished on 07.05.2024.

All the bail applications stand disposed off.
