It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for applicant that applicant is the elder son of his family. His mother is widow, who is totally dependent upon him. It is submitted that applicant's younger brother requires treatment of eyes for which he requires 15 days interim bail.

Bail application is strongly opposed by Ld. Substitute Additional Public Prosecutor on the ground that applicant has no younger brother and that Sanjay, who is stated to be younger brother, is only residing with the family of applicant.

I have considered the submissions. It appears that Sh. Sanjay is not the brother of applicant but is residing with his family for a long time. Therefore, his health is a matter of concern for the applicant. Considering all facts and circumstances, **I admit the applicant Vikas @ Deepak @ Kana (A-2) to bail for a period of 10 days from the date of his release on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.15,000/- with one surety in like amount.** After 10 such days, applicant shall surrender in this court or in jail.

Application is disposed of accordingly.
