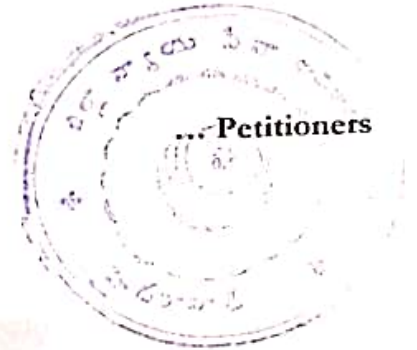

Claim: Petition under Section 166 of M.V. Act for compensation of Rs.5,00,000/- for the injuries sustained by petitioner in road accident occurred on 24.7.2022 at about 7.10p.m within the limits of P.S. Shankerpally and it has registered a case in Crime No.356/2022 under Sec.337 of IPC against Car No. TS-34J-3054.

This case referred by the above Court coming on this day for settlement before the Lok Adalat in presence of Petitioner(s) and his/her/ Counsel; Respondent No. 1 and 2 remained absent / exparte; and counsel for Respondent No.3/Spl. Vakalat holder; and after conciliation the settlement is arrived between the parties, the following award is passed.

AWARD

UNDER SECTION 21 OF THE L.S.A. ACT 1987 & AMENDMENT ACT 1994



- (a) The Respondent No.3, Insurance Co-shall pay to the Petitioner a sum of Rs.2,40,000/- (Rupees Two lakhs forty thousand only) as compensation for the injury of S. Bhagiah S/o S. Laxmatah, injuries sustained towards full and final settlement of all claims arising out of the said accident.
- (b) No interest or costs shall be payable to the Petitioner(s)
- (c) The petition as against the Respondent No. 1&2 shall stand dismissed without costs in view of the settlement arrived at between the Petitioner(s) and Respondent No.3.
- (d) An amount of Rs. _____ of Petitioner No. _____ shall be invested in fixed deposits in any Nationalized Bank for a period of one year. The Petitioner No. _____ can withdraw interest monthly / quarterly.
- (e) The remaining compensation amounts of Rs. _____ payable to minor Petitioner Nos. _____ shall be invested in fixed deposits in any Nationalized Bank, initially for a period of one year to be renewed till attain majority. The Petitioner No. 1 being guardian of the minor Petitioner(s) can withdraw interest monthly / quarterly.
- (f) The Respondent No. 3 is / are directed to deposit the compensation amount within one month from the date of this award failing which interest will be calculated on the amount of compensation awarded at the rate of 9% p.a. from the date of award till realization.
- (g) Petitioner(s) is/are entitled for refund of Court Fee paid as per Section 21(1) Legal Services Authority Act, 1987.

In token of consent for the above settlement and award, the parties and their counsel have signed this award in our presence.
