Today, matter is fixed for filing FSL report / consideration
of an application moved on behalf of the applicant / accused **Salman** for
grant of interim bail for a period of 20 days.

Inspector Vijay Singh is present and he has filed the reply of
the above said application and further submits that FSL report has been
received and supplementary charge sheet shall be filed within 02 weeks
from today.

1. As far as the application moved on behalf of accused
Salman is concerned, it is submitted by Ld. counsel for the applicant /
accused that the marriage of the sister of the applicant / accused is
scheduled for 04.04.2026 as well as for performing the rituals between
25.03.2026 to 15.04.2026 and being the only male member, the presence

of the applicant / accused is required for performing the rituals and hence, it is requested that present application be allowed.

2. On the other hand, Ld. Addl. PP for the State has argued on the present application and opposed the same.

3. The applicant / accused is claiming interim bail to attend the marriage of his sister which is scheduled for 04.04.2026 as well as for performing the rituals between 25.03.2026 to 15.04.2026. Today, Ms. Sadma i.e bua of the applicant / accused is also present and she submits that the father and mother of the applicant / accused has already expired and the applicant / accused is the only member in the family to perform the rituals. Further, the said facts have also been confirmed by the IO and same are found to be genuine. Hence, in view of the submissions made above and without commenting on merits and on humanitarian grounds, **the applicant is admitted to interim bail with effect from 24.03.2026 to 07.04.2026** subject to furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs. 30,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of this Court. **It is made clear that no further application for regular bail / extension of bail would be entertained without surrendering before the Court.**

4. Accused shall abide by the following conditions:-

i) During the period of interim bail, applicant / accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not communicate with or come in contact with the complainant/victim or any member of the complainant/victim's family or tamper with the evidence of the case.

5. Applicant / accused is directed to surrender before the Jail Superintendent / Court on the expiry of the period of interim bail i.e 07.04.2026 on or before 05:00 p.m. **Application (IA No.12/2026) stands disposed of accordingly.**

6. Re-notify the matter for **compliance** on 29.04.2026. Let IO be also summoned for the said date. Copy of this order be given dasti to the Ld. counsel for the applicant / accused, as prayed for. Copy of this order be also sent to Jail Superintendent for information and compliance.
