Today, matter is fixed for arguments on charge.

Ld. counsel for all accused has moved separate bail applications and submits that earlier accused were on bail and later on by the observation of Ld. MM, it was observed that offence u/s 397 IPC is also made out and accordingly, matter was committed to Sessions Courts, and it is prayed that all accused be again re-admitted to bail.

Per contra, the bail applications are opposed by Ld. Addl PP for the state.

In view of the submissions made above, all accused are re-admitted to bail subject to furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- each with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of this Court. Bail bonds are already on record.

All 3 bail applications are disposed of accordingly.

Arguments on charge heard on behalf of all accused.

I have given thoughtful consideration to the submissions of Ld. counsel. However, at the stage of charge, it is to be seen whether the material on record when corralled together is sufficient enough to raise the strong suspicion of the commission of the offence by the all accused persons .

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I have perused the statement of complainant and material document. There is sufficient material on record to frame charge against all accused u/s 393/394/397/323/427/458 IPC r/w Section 120 B IPC. Charge framed separately to which all accused pleaded not guilty and claimed trial.

Re-notify the matter for **PE on 17.03.2025**.

Let complainant be summoned for said date.
