File taken up today on application under Section 483 BNSS filed on behalf of applicant/accused Bansilal @ Lal, seeking regular bail.

Present: Sh. Ashish Dahiya, Ld. CLADC for applicant/accused Bansilal @ Lal.

SI Sunny Khatri has filed reply of SI Sandeep.

Heard. Perused.

Ld. CLADC for applicant/accused Bansilal @ Lal prays for enlarging applicant/accused Bansilal @ Lal on bail on the following premise. Applicant/accused Bansilal @ Lal is under detention since 14/02/2024; is innocent and falsely implicated, whereas trial is likely to take time to conclude and there is no likelihood of applicant/accused Bansilal @ Lal for absconding from law or tampering with evidence.

Ld. Additional Public Prosecutor for State has opposed the plea of bail, submitting applicant/accused Bansilal @ Lal is facing trial for serious offence of attempt to murder, having allegedly stabbed Lalit with knife in the lower back and lower abdomen, resulting in knife getting stuck and injured Lalit suffered grievous injuries.

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: 2 :

First informant PW1 Sh. Sanjay in deposition before my Ld. Predecessor stated of having reached the scene of crime on call of injured Lalit and having seen injured Lalit in pool of blood, knife inside the back of body of Lalit, blood coming from there, whereas persons there were holding accused Bansilal @ Lala there.

On 22/08/2025 injured Lalit was examined-in-chief as PW3 but could not be cross examined that day by his Defence Counsel as lawyers were abstaining from work. PW3 Lalit identified the knife as Ex P-2 to be the one by which he had received injuries inflicted by applicant/accused Bansilal @ Lala on the morning of incident and had narrated the incident in terms of case of prosecution put forth; further narrating that earlier applicant/accused Bansilal @ Lala had started stalking his daughter, due to which hot altercation between PW3 and applicant/accused Bansilal @ Lala took place earlier, resulting in PW3 sending his daughter to Canada for studies; after which applicant/accused Bansilal @ Lala started giving threats to kill him.

PW3 Lalit is yet to be cross examined; for which he is summoned for next date of hearing i.e., 19/11/2025. Enlarging applicant/accused Bansilal @ Lala on bail at this stage may result in his influencing, coercing, threatening injured PW3 Lalit

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and considering the nature, gravity of the offence in question; at this stage of the case; no case of bail is made out for enlarging applicant/accused Bansilal @ Lala on bail.

Bail application of applicant/accused Bansilal @ Lala is dismissed.

Put up on date already fixed i.e., 19/11/2025 for prosecution evidence.

As prayed, copy of this order be given dasti to Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused Bansilal @ Lala.

Copy of the order be also sent to the concerned Jail Superintendent for information.
