Today, matter is fixed for filing further investigation qua  
accused Neeraj Gujjar as well as FSL report and filing reply of the  
application for releasing the vehicle nos. DL-9SCF-9405 (Hero  
Splendor) on superdari on behalf of the applicant / owner namely  
Nishant.

1. It is submitted by the Ld. counsel for the applicant that the  
**vehicle bearing no. DL-9SCF-9405 (Hero Splendor)** is no more required  
by the investigating agency and present applicant is the registered owner  
of the said vehicle and wants to get the same released. It is further  
submitted by the Ld. counsel for the applicant that applicant undertakes  
to produce the said vehicle as and when directed by the Court and hence,  
it is requested that the present application be allowed.

2. Reply has been filed by the IO. Copy supplied. As per the  
report, IO has no objection, if the **vehicle bearing no. DL-9SCF-9405  
(Hero Splendor)** be released to its registered owner.

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3. Heard. Perused.

4. The vehicle cannot be kept in malkhana for a long time. Accordingly, in view of the same, the present application stands allowed. **Vehicle bearing no. DL-9SCF-9405 (Hero Splendor) be released to the registered owner** against due receipt and verification, as per rules subject to furnishing of superdginama / panchnama along with indemnity bond in sum of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand Only) to the satisfaction of the SHO/IO. The registered owner shall also file on record the photographs of said vehicle from different angles and will produce the vehicle in question in court as and when required by the Court. It is also made clear that the registered owner will not sell the vehicle in question till the disposal of the present matter without the prior permission of the Court. SHO/IO is also directed to do all the needful before releasing the vehicle. SHO/IO shall file all the records of superdari before the Court before the next date of hearing. **Application (IA No.02/2026) stands disposed of accordingly.**

5. Let IO be again summoned for **02.06.2026**. Copy of this order be given dasti to the Ld. counsel for the applicant, as prayed for.
