Ltd.

Advocate Sh. M.C. Premi for R1/Nizamuddin insists that R2/Reliance General Insurance Co. Ltd. being the principal would be liable to indemnify owner/insured for the wrongful act of its agent notwithstanding the fact that insurance policy of vehicle No. DL-9CJ-2251 was found to be fake.

Put up on **24.08.2024** for submissions and citing case laws w.r.t. liability of insurance company to indemnify the owner in case of fake insurance policy.
