1. Ld. defence counsel has moved two bail applications and submits that investigation is complete. It is further submitted by the Ld. counsel for the accused persons that charge sheet was filed without arresting the accused persons and it is prayed that both accused persons be granted bail.

2. On the other hand, Ld. Addl. PP for the State has submitted that both applications be dealt, as per law.

3. The record reveals that during the investigation, both accused persons were not arrested and they have been charge sheeted for the offences under Sections 74/76/79/351(2)/115/3(5) BNS without arresting them.

4. In view of the submissions made above, both accused persons are hereby granted bail on furnishing bail bond in sum of Rs.20,000/- with one surety of like amount each.

5. Further, accused persons shall abide by the following conditions:

i) Accused persons will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

ii) Accused persons shall provide permanent address to the Court. The accused shall intimate the Court by way of an affidavit and to the IO regarding any change in residential address.

iii) Accused persons shall appear before the Court as and when the matter is taken up for hearing unless exempted.

iv) Accused persons shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not communicate with or come in contact with the complainant/victim or any member of the complainant/victim's family or tamper with the evidence of the case. It is made clear that the State would be at liberty to file application for cancellation of the bail of the applicant / accused, if present applicant involves himself in the similar nature of offence.

6. **Both applications stand disposed of accordingly.** At request, re-notify the matter for **arguments on charge / furnishing the bail bonds** on **21.08.2025**. Let IO be also summoned for the said date.
