State Vs. Ishwar Singh

Proceedings qua accused Anil Kumar already abated

Accused Ishwar Singh on bail is present.

PW-3 HC Sunil Kumar is examined, cross-examined and discharged.

PW Ashish Gupta and Ramesh Kumar (the complainant) are present for their examination. However, counsel for the accused submits that the accused has moved the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi for quashing of the subject FIR and prays that examination of the said witnesses may be deferred. He filed copy of the order dated 04.08.2026 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in Criminal M.C. no.5613/2026.

Perusal of the abovementioned order dated 04.08.2026 reveals that, that day, none appeared for the petitioner therein/complainant herein despite pass over. On the other hand, today, the accused is seeking deferment of examination of the said witnesses on the pretext of pendency of the said petition. As such, the accused is taking advantage of its own. However, in the interest of justice, the request is allowed subject to the cost of Rs.3,000/- to be deposited with DLSA, South-West District, Dwarka Courts, Delhi.

In the given circumstances, police witnesses namely SI Navneet Singh and Insp. Rashmi be summoned for the next date of hearing.
