Present: Sh. Tarun Soni and Vivek Sharma, Ld. Counsel for plaintiff.

Today the matter is fixed for further proceedings.

On the previous date of hearing summons of settlement of issues were issued to defendant. As per process server's report defendant has been served.

None appears for defendant.

Counsel for plaintiff presses his application u/o XXXIX Rule 1 and 2 CPC.

Perusal of the record shows that present suit has been filed for partition, possession and recovery of use and occupation charges. As per the plaint, plaintiff and defendant are real sisters and daughters of Late Smt. Ravinder Kaur and Late Sh. Gurdev Singh. It is stated that their mother Late Sh. Ravinder Kaur was the absolute owner of the suit property and as plaintiff and defendant are her Class-I legal heirs, both are entitled to equal share of $\frac{1}{2}$ in the suit property.

Considering that despite service of summons defendant has chosen not to appear, this court considers it fit to direct both the parties to maintain status quo till the next date of hearing.
