1. By this order I shall decide the regular bail application filed by the applicant Deepak @ Deepu u/s 483 BNSS 2023.
2. Ld. Counsel for the applicant has argued that this is the 2nd bail application. This first was dismissed on 17.08.2024. he submits that the star witness has now been examined. All the other witnesses are official witness. The nature of injury in the MLC is simple, accused is behind bars for the last 2 years. He is sole bread earner. Motive and intention

has not been proved. Hence he is laible to be admitted to bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. Addl. PP for the State submits that this is 3rd bail application. The first was dismissed on 08.05.2023. The 2nd was dismissed on 17.08.2024. Six wounds are present on the body of the injured. FSL report is still pending and the applicant is clearly seen in the CCTV footage attacking the victim. He submits that injured is yet to be examined and Bimla Devi one of the eye witness has fully supported the case of the prosecution.
4. I have heard Ld. Counsel for the applicant, Ld. Addl. PP for the State and perused the record.
5. In the present case a complaint was made by Bimla Devi to the effect that there was some altercation between her son Deepak and neighbour Hari. After sometime the son of Hari i.e. the present applicant came to know about the altercation. At around 4:30 pm he came in inebriated condition and started abusing, after hearing the noise her son Sunil went outside the gali. The son of her neighbour i.e. applicant started giving knife blows. After inflicting injuries he ran away from the spot.
6. Injured was taken to RML Hospital where he was medically examined vide MLC dated 18.10.2022 at 6.13 p.m. which records the following injuries upon the injured :

Incised wound (R) Ear Pinna (2x1x0.5 cm)

Abrasion (L) Eyebrow 1x1 cm

Incised wound (R) Lumb on region 2x0.5x0.5cm

Incised wound (L) Arm 3x10 cm x 0.5 cm

Incised wound (L) forearm 3x1.5x1 cm

*6 Incised wound (L) over (L) side of chest-
1x0.5x0.5 cm and 0.5x0.3x0.5 cm*

7. During investigation, the applicant was arrested and weapon of offence i.e. blood stained knife was recovered at the instance of the applicant upon which the FSL result is still pending.
8. The charge-sheet reveals that the CCTV footage of the incident was also gathered in which at 4.31 p.m., the applicant can be seen attacking the victim Sunil with knife.
9. The applicant is specifically named in the FIR. The FSL result is yet to be obtained. The role of the applicant is clear in the commission of the present offence. The weapon of offence has also been recovered from the applicant.
10. The earlier bail application of the applicant was dismissed on 08.05.2023 and 17.08.2024 vide detailed order. PW-1 Bimla Devi has been examined who has supported the case of the prosecution. The injured is yet to be examined. The allegations against the applicant are grave and serious.
11. Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the present case, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the applicant.
12. Application filed by the applicant for grant of regular bail is hereby dismissed.
13. Copy of this order be given dasti to the Id. Counsel for the applicant.

14. A hard as well as soft copy of this order be also sent to the concerned Jail Superintendent for information and necessary action.
15. The application is disposed of in above terms.
