Petitions dated:05.09.2022 to condone the delay of 6 days in filing the extension petition and to grant further 7 days time to comply the condition in CMP.No.3080/2022 dated: 07.09.2022.

These petitions are coming on this day for hearing before me, in the presence of Thiru.K.Devaram, Advocate for the petitioners in both the petitions and the Public Prosecutor for the respondent and upon hearing both sides arguments, this court passed the following :

COMMON ORDER

Heard both sides. The petitioners, who were granted anticipatory bail Vide the order of the Principal Sessions Judge, Salem in CMP.No.2080/2022 dated:07.09.2022 with a condition to surrender before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.1, Mettur within 15 days from the date of the order and to execute a bond each for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.1, Mettur have come forward with these petitions seeking to condone the delay of 6 days in filing extension petition and to grant further 7 days time to comply the condition in CMP. No.2080/2022 dated:07.09.2022.

The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner was suddenly affected by severe viral fever and as per the advice of the Doctor he was in bed rest for 3 weeks, he was not able to surrender before the Court concerned within the time stipulated by this Court, hence pray for condoning the delay of 6 days and extending the time.

The learned Public Prosecutor has not raised any serious objection to allow these petitions.

Considering the facts and circumstances, in order to give an opportunity to the petitioners, the petition in CMP No.3408/2022 is allowed, the delay is condoned and the petitioners are directed to surrender before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.1, Mettur within 7 days from the date of this order, failing which the petition in CMP No.3409/2022 shall stand dismissed. Thus these petitions are allowed.
