ORDER

The matter is suo moto advanced to this day and placed before the National Lok Adalath. Accused/A1 to A6 are present. Offence alleged punishable u.Sec.379 IPC. Accused are examined u.Sec.239 Cr.P.C. The substance of accusation is read over and explained to them in Telugu. Having understood the same, accused pleaded guilty voluntarily. Satisfied with the plea of guilty tendered by accused, as it is a voluntary one. Accordingly, the accused are found guilty for the offence under Section 379 IPC. The accused are explained as to the quantum of sentence prescribed under the law. Plea of accused is prayed the court to take lenient view. Hence, considering the same, the court is inclined to convict them u.Sec.241 Cr.P.C for the offence u.Sec., 379 IPC. Taking the plea of the accused into consideration, this court is of the view that sentencing the accused to pay fine would meet the ends of justice. In the result, the accused/A1 to A6 are found guilty and they are convicted u.Sec.241 Cr.P.C. The accused are sentenced to pay fine of Rs.600.00 (Rupees Six Hundred only) each for the offence u.Sec.379 of IPC, in default of payment of fine they shall undergo S.I for a period of one month. Total fine amount is Rs.3,600.00 The seized property i.e., Passion Pro Motor cycle and rods of different length which were given towards interim custody of the respective owners vide proceedings of this Court, shall be made absolute, after lapse of appeal period. The SHO, P.S.Mudigonda is hereby directed to return the unmarked case property i.e., Auto, to the concerned owners on proper identification and due acknowledgment and file the same before the court. Office is directed to issue receipt for payment of fine, if paid, so also to remit the fine amount to the State forthwith.
