**JUDGMENT
(Delivered on 12-11-2022)**

ORDER

The matter is suo moto advanced to this day and is placed before the National Lok Adalath. Police present. Summons served. Accused is present. Copies furnished to him. Offence alleged against the accused is punishable u.Sec.270, 273 IPC. Accused is examined u.Sec. 251 Cr.P.C. The substance of accusation is readover and explained to him in Telugu. Having understood the same, accused is pleaded guilty voluntarily. Satisfied with the plea of guilt tendered by Accused, as it is a voluntary one. Accordingly, the accused is found guilty under Section 252 Cr.P.C. The accused is explained as to the quantum of sentence prescribed under the law. Plea of accused are considered and court is inclined to find guilty U/Sec.252 Cr.P.C for the offence under sections 270, 273 IPC. The accused submitted that this is only the case involved by them and they will be careful hereinafter. Hence, prayed the court to take lenient view considering the same. Taking the plea of the accused into consideration. I am of the view that sentencing the accused to pay fine would meet the ends of justice. In the result, the Accused are found guilty for the offence under Sections 270, 273 IPC. As such, accused is convicted under section 252 Cr.P.C. The Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.1000.00 (Rupees One thousand only) in default of payment of fine, the Accused shall undergo S.I for a period of 1 month for the offence under section 270, 273 IPC. Total fine amount of Rs.1000.00. The unmarked case property i.e., 1) Goa -355 packets, W/Rs.5400/-, 2) Amber-1525 packets, W/Rs.45,750/-, 3) RR Tobacco-4 packets, W/Rs.3200/-, 4) Vimal-270 packets, W/Rs.2700/-, 5) V1-tobacco -330 packets, w/Rs.1650/-, 6) J.K. Jarda 12 packets, W/Rs.1200/-, total 2501 packets, W/Rs.59,900/- shall be destroyed after lapse of appeal period. The unmarked case property I.e motorcycle already given to its owner vide Crl.M.P.No.528/2022, dt. 03.11.2022. The concerned police are directed to file requisition to destroy the property. Office is directed to issue receipt for payment of fine, if paid, so also to remit the fine amount to the State forthwith.
