Sh. R. N. Dubey, Ld. counsel for the defendant.
PW-1, who is the husband of the plaintiff, is present
in person.

Ld. counsel for the defendant states that the plaintiff
has failed to file on record her evidence by way of affidavit and he
wants to cross-examine the plaintiff first because in the connected
matter in between the same parties, which is pending before the
Court of Ld. District Judge-01, District Shahdara, Karkardooma
Courts, Delhi, the plaintiff herein has already examined herself as a
witness. It has been further submitted that in case, the husband of
the plaintiff is cross-examined first, then, the case of the defendant
is going to be prejudiced.

At this stage, ld. counsel for the plaintiff states that the plaintiff does not want to examine herself as one of the witness in the present suit. Ld counsel for the plaintiff has got recorded his statement to this effect that plaintiff shall not be examined in the present suit.

The affidavit of PW-1 Sh. Pankaj Singh, the husband of the plaintiff, has been tendered in part and the further examination-in-chief has been deferred for want of originals, at the request of ld. counsel for the plaintiff.

Request for adjournment is strongly opposed. There is no explanation as to why the witness has failed to produce the original documents, if the documents are to be tendered in evidence.

In these circumstances, subject to the costs of Rs.5000/- to be deposited with DLSA, South-West District, Dwarka Courts, New Delhi by the plaintiff, PW-1 is granted final opportunity to produce original documents which are in his power, possession and are mentioned in the evidence by way of affidavit on the next date.

Ld. counsel for the plaintiff shall also place on record the evidence by way of affidavit of all the PWs with advance copy to the Ld. counsel for the defendant by the next date.

At the request of Ld. counsel for the plaintiff, to come up for entire PE on **07.09.2026**.
