These are three bail applications seeking anticipatory bail to applicants Gautam Bhatia, Sanjay Gulati and Arun Kumar Sharma.

Vide this common order, I shall dispose of the three bail applications bearing nos. 871/2026, 872/2026 and 873/2026 respectively as they arise out of the same FIR.

Heard. Record perused.

The allegations against the applicants are that they have cheated the complainant of Rs. 3,50,000/- on the pretext of air ticket bookings. It is now reported by the parties that they have compromised the matter vide mediation settlement dated 01.06.2026 and in pursuance of the settlement, the complainant has been paid Rs. 50,000/- and the remaining amount is to be paid in installments.

The complainant is present with his counsel and he submits that he has no objection to the present bail applications.

Since the matter has been compromised between the parties, it is directed that in the event of arrest the applicants Gautam Bhatia, Sanjay Gulati and Arun Kumar Sharma be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 20,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of IO/SHO concerned.
