Accused produced from JC (*already discharged in the present case vide order dated 18.11.2025*)
Sh V.S Chauhan, Ld LADC for the accused.

Matter is listed today for furnishing of bail bond and surety bond by the accused in terms of Section 481 BNSS, 2023, the accused having been discharged by the Ld. Predecessor of this Court vide order dated 18.11.2025.

Ld. LADC for the accused submits that the bail bond and surety bond contemplated under Section 481 BNSS, 2023, which is pari materia to Section 437A Cr.P.C., are required to remain in force only for a period of six months. It is submitted that since the accused was discharged vide order dated 18.11.2025, the said period of six months has already expired. It is further submitted that the accused is presently in judicial custody in some other case and therefore, no useful purpose would be served by insisting upon furnishing of bail bond and surety bond at this stage.

Heard. Record perused.

Section 481 BNSS, 2023, requires the accused to execute bail bond with sureties for appearance before the higher Court in the event of filing of appeal/petition against the judgment/order. Such bond is to remain in force for a period of six months.

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In the present case, the accused was discharged vide order dated 18.11.2025. The period of six months from the date of the discharge order has already expired. In these circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by directing the accused to furnish bail bond and surety bond under Section 481 BNSS, 2023 at this stage.

Accordingly, the requirement of furnishing bail bond and surety bond under Section 481 BNSS, 2023 is dispensed with.

Accused be released forthwith in the present case, if not required in any other case.

Bail bond and surety bond of the accused, if any, stand discharged.

File be consigned to Record Room after due compliance.
