This is an application under Section 439 CrPC moved on behalf of the applicant/accused for extension of interim bail.

Reply to application filed by the IO. Copy supplied.

It is submitted by ld. Counsel for applicant/accused that applicant was granted interim bail under the guidelines of HPC and his interim bail is going to expire today. It is further submitted that mother of applicant had expired on 20.08.2021 and rituals after death of a person in Muslim community takes 40 days from the date of death, which will expire on 30.09.2021 and shall be completed in the native village of applicant. It is further submitted that interim bail of applicant may be extended so that he can perform all rituals in respect of his deceased mother.

Heard. Perused.

Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case, the fact that presence of applicant is required to perform the pending rituals of his deceased mother and purely on humanitarian ground, the interim bail of the applicant/accused is extended for a further period of 20 (twenty) days from today, on the same terms and conditions.

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It is specifically ordered that the interim bail of applicant/accused is extended for only 20 days and thereafter he shall surrender before the concerned Jail Authority and no further extension whatsoever shall be granted to him.

The application stands disposed of accordingly.
