This is a bail application under Section 439 Cr.PC moved on behalf of the applicant/accused for grant of interim bail to enable him to attend the marriage of his brother.

Arguments heard.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused submits that interim bail is being sought for 30 days on the ground of marriage of his brother as he has to make necessary arrangements for the same. He further submits that he had remained on interim bail for two years and had never jumped bail. He undertakes to comply any condition of the bail.

Reply to the interim bail application is filed by IO wherein the marriage of the brother of accused/ applicant has been verified.

No ground for granting interim bail for 30 days is made out.

At this juncture, ld. counsel applicant/accused at Bar submits that though the present application is moved for grant of interim bail, the applicant/accused may be allowed to attend the marriage of his brother in custody parole.

Submissions heard. Record perused.

Alongwith the application, the wedding card of the brother of the accused has been annexed, perusal of which reveals that the brother of applicant/accused is scheduled to get married on 08.12.2023. The Barat shall proceed from RZ-B-70, Vishwa Vihar, near Bindapur Village to Hari Om Tent, Norangabad Cantt., Aligarh, UP at 11:30 am.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the applicant/accused, the verbal prayer of the applicant/accused is allowed and the concerned Jail Superintendent is directed to make necessary arrangements to take the applicant/accused Vishal Kumar @ Yashirou in custody parole to the venue stated above on 08.12.2023 well within time so as to attend the marriage ceremony starting from 11:00 am on that day and to accompany him to the venue of marriage at Aligarh, UP till 12:00 midnight, in proper security. It is further directed that immediately on solemnization of marriage of the brother of the accused, the applicant/accused be brought back to the Jail. It is further directed that the security personnel may preferably accompany the applicant/accused in plain clothes during custody parole.

Application stands disposed of accordingly.

Copy of this order be also sent to the concerned Jail Superintendent for information and compliance along with photocopy of the wedding card.

Copy of the order be given dasti to learned counsel for the applicant/accused.
