Ld. Addl.PP for the State submits that a CD containing the CCTV footage was received from FSL. He further submits that prosecution does not have the copy of the footage. He requests for getting the footage in the pen drive for prosecution. He further submits that this court is not equipped with the computer system having CD drive and, therefore, CD cannot be played in the court's system. Ld. Addl.PP has submitted that since the laptops having the CD drive have also become redundant, it is becoming difficult for the IO to bring such laptops. Therefore, IO be allowed to put an additional pen drive on record containing the CCTV footage copied from the CD received from the FSL.

Ld. Counsels for accused Vishal Kumar @ Yasghirou and Mohd. Sarwar Ali submit that they have already been supplied with the copy of the CD.

The CD has been played in the laptop today brought by the IO. Same is seen by the Ld. Addl.PP as well as ld.

Counsels for accused Vishal Kumar @ Yasghirou and Mohd. Sarwar Ali and they confirm that the footage contained in the CD received from FSL is the same which has been supplied to them. They further give their no objection to place the pen drive on record by the IO after copying the footage from the CD received from FSL with the help of Computer Branch, Dwarka Courts Complex, Delhi.

In view of the submissions made by Ld. Addl.PP for the State and no objection given by ld. Counsels for accused Vishal Kumar @ Yasghirou and Mohd. Sarwar Ali, the request of Ld. Addl.PP is allowed.

The contents of the said CD are put in an empty pen drive with the help of the Computer Branch's staff, Dwarka Courts Complex, Delhi.

The pen drive as well as CD containing the footage are now tagged with the judicial file. An additional pen drive is handed over to the Ld. Addl.PP for the State containing the said footage.

PW-1 Sh. Shammi Gupta further examined, cross examined and discharged.

Summons issued to PW-Sunny received back unserved. **The summons were directed to be served through IO whereas the same have been served through other police official.**

Incharge VB is directed to comply with the order of this court in its letter and spirit.

Let PW-Sunny be summoned afresh through IO/Insp. Rajeev Yadav for NDOH. SHO is directed to comply with the directions. Copy of this order be sent to concerned SHO for compliance.

Put up for PE on 20.01.2025.
