File taken up today on an application under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 moved on behalf of the applicant/accused Vishal seeking interim bail.

Present: Sh. Vijender Kharb, ld. Addl. PP for the State.

Sh. R.S. Bind, ld. counsel for applicant/accused Sarvar Ali @ Sajjan.

Ld. counsel for the applicant/accused has submitted that wife of the applicant/accused is suffering from enlargement of liver for which she is undergoing treatment from Asha Hospital. Ld. counsel for the applicant/accused has further submitted that applicant/accused has three minor children and there is no other adult member in the family to take care of his ailing wife and minor children. Ld. counsel for the applicant/accused has prayed for grant of interim bail to the applicant/accused for a period of one month to take care of his wife and children.

On the other hand, ld. Addl. PP for the State has opposed the interim bail application stating that the applicant/accused is involved in serious offence and therefore, the present application be dismissed.

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I have heard. Id. counsel for the applicant/accused as well as Id. Addl. PP for the State and have perused the record carefully.

The applicant/accused is seeking interim bail on the ground of illness of his wife. Alongwith the application, the applicant/accused has also annexed medical documents of his wife. The medical documents regarding illness of wife of applicant/accused have been duly verified and verification report has been filed on behalf of IO. Same is perused.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the ground on which the applicant/accused is seeking interim bail i.e. for taking care of his ailing wife and his minor children, the Considering the grounds for which the applicant/accused is seeking interim bail and the submissions made, the applicant/accused Sarvar Ali @ Sajjan is admitted to interim bail for a period of ten (10) days from the date of his release, on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety in the like amount, subject to the following condition:-

- (i) he shall provide his mobile number to the IO/SHO concerned and shall drop google pin of his mobile number and keep his mobile phone ON for 24X7 and shall not switch off the same during the period of his interim bail; and
- (ii) he shall not try to contact/influence the public witnesses directly or indirectly in any manner whatsoever during the period of his interim bail.

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(iii) he shall not indulge himself in any criminal activity/offence during the period of his interim bail.

It is made clear that since interim bail has been granted to the applicant/accused owing to illness of his wife, this order shall remain effective for a period of thirty days from today.

The applicant/accused is directed to surrender before the concerned Jail Superintendent immediately on expiry of period of his interim bail.

Application stands disposed of accordingly.

A copy of this order be sent to the concerned Jail Superintendent for intimating the applicant/accused.

As prayed, copy of the order be given dasti to learned counsel for the applicant/accused.
