This is an interim bail application moved on behalf of accused Sarvar Ali @ Sajjan for a period of one month.

Reply has already been filed. Copy already supplied.

Ld. Counsel for accused has argued that wife of the applicant/accused is suffering from left facial cellulitis and is taking treatment from DDU Hospital. He has further argued that the doctor advised her for admission in the hospital as the swelling of the mouth is spreading and only one finger can be entered into her mouth. Ld. counsel has further argued that there are three minor children of applicant/accused and there is nobody in the family of applicant/accused to take care of his wife and get her medically treated.

On the other hand, Ld. Addl. PP for State has opposed the application by stating that the offence is heinous in nature and has submitted that the present bail application be dismissed.

I have heard the arguments and have perused the record carefully.

As per the reply filed today, the medical documents of the wife of the applicant/accused were duly verified.

Hence in view of the abovesaid reply, applicant/accused Sarvar Ali @ Sajjan is admitted to interim bail for a period of one week on furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 15,000/- with one surety of like amount from the date of his release. Accused is directed to positively surrender before the Jail Superintendent on the expiry of said one week. The aforesaid bail is granted subject to following conditions:-

(i) Accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity in any manner whatsoever during the period of his interim bail.

(ii) Accused shall not approach the witnesses, who have not been examined, directly or indirectly in any manner whatsoever.

(iii) Accused shall keep his mobile phone open 24x7 and shall intimate the IO about any change in his contact number.

With these directions, application stands disposed off.

Copy of this order be given dasti to the applicant/accused and be also sent to concerned Jail Superintendent.
