File taken up today on an application moved on behalf of the applicant/accused seeking interim bail for taking care of his mother who sustained injury.

Sh. R.S. Bind, ld. counsel for applicant/accused Vishal Kumar.

Reply to the application has been filed by Insp. Ranjit Tokas. Copy of the same is supplied to ld. counsel for the applicant/accused.

Ld. counsel for the applicant/accused submits that mother of the applicant/accused met with an accident on 05.06.2026 in which her left foot was got injured and she also suffered multiple injuries in her whole body. Ld. counsel for the applicant/accused further submits that there is no one in the family to take care of his mother and therefore, the applicant/accused be granted interim bail for a period of one month to take care of his ailing mother.

On the other hand, ld. Addl. PP for the State has opposed the application submitting that the applicant/accused is involved in serious offence of murder. Ld. Addl. PP for the State

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further submits that incident wherein the mother of the applicant/accused is stated to have sustained injuries, is dated 05.06.2026 and she has already got treatment for the said injuries from Mata Chanan Devi Hospital. Ld. Addl. PP for the State further submits that there are other members in the family who can take care of ailing mother of the applicant/accused and therefore, the application be dismissed.

I have heard ld. counsel for the applicant/accused and have perused the record carefully.

Reply to the application has been filed by Insp. Ranjit Tokas. In the reply, it is stated that house of the applicant/accused was visited where father of the applicant/accused was found present who informed that he has four sons including applicant/accused Vishal.

The accident wherein the mother of the applicant/accused received foot injury is stated to be of dated 05.06.2026. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the reply filed by the IO, no ground is made out to grant interim bail to the applicant/accused.

The present application seeking interim bail by applicant/accused Vishal Kumar is hereby dismissed.

As prayed, copy of the order be given dasti to learned counsel for the applicant/accused.
