This is an application under Section 439 CrPC moved on behalf of the applicant/accused for grant of interim bail/extension of interim bail granted to him vide order dated 18.06.2020.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the applicant/accused that vide order dated 18.06.2020 the applicant/accused was granted interim bail till today i.e. 04.07.2020 for attending the marriage of his cousin sister. Learned counsel for the applicant/accused has submitted that parents of the applicant/accused are aged persons, who are suffering from various old age ailments. It is further submitted that the parents of the applicant/accused are suffering from fever, headache, throat infection as well as breathing problem and there is none in the family to take care of them and there is all possibility that they might be infected from COVID-19. Learned counsel for the applicant/accused has also annexed the medical prescription of parents of the applicant/accused alongwith the bail

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application and submitted that COVID test of both the parents of the applicant/accused is yet to be conducted. Learned counsel for the applicant/accused has prayed for extension of interim bail granted to him vide order dated 18.06.2020 submitting that in the present situation of COVID-19 pandemic prevalent in the country, the parents of the applicant/accused needs extra care.

Addl. PP for the State has opposed the prayer for extension of interim bail on the ground that interim bail was granted to the applicant/accused for specific purpose and till today, no COVID test was got conducted by the parents of the applicant/accused.

In view of the submissions made above, the interim bail of the applicant/accused is extended for a period of ten days on the same terms and conditions. Applicant/accused is directed to place on record the COVID test reports of his parents two days prior to the next date of hearing, through email of Reader of this Court.

At request, list the bail application **through video conferencing on 14.07.2020** for consideration.

A copy of this order be sent to the concerned Jail Superintendent for intimation.
