Matter is listed today for compliance regarding deposit of 75% of the awarded amount alongwith up to date interest as well as filing of arbitral record.

At this stage, Id. Counsel for petitioner has filed an application under section 151 CPC seeking extension of time for depositing 75% of the awarded amount.

Id. Counsel for the petitioner submits that due to some technical issues with respect to the account of petitioner, the petitioner could not prepare the demand draft of 75% of the awarded amount alongwith up to date interest and hence, he is seeking one more opportunity for depositing the 75% of the awarded amount.

At the request of Id. Counsel for the petitioner, last and final opportunity is granted to the petitioner to deposit the 75% of the awarded amount alongwith up to date interest subject to costs of Rs. 2,000/- to be paid by petitioner to the respondent.
