Evidence affidavit of Sunil Sharma has been filed. It appears that this is a case of death and legal offer was filed by insurance company. Therefore, the only question is about enhancement of compensation and nothing else.

Arguments heard.

The insurance company has taken Rs.30,000/- per year as income of the deceased and has accordingly, calculated the compensation. The deceased was is minor of 14 years of age. Now, it has been settled that in such cases, minimum wages of skilled person should be considered alongwith multiplier of 18.

Once this is so, the actual calculation will be as under:

There is nothing on record to show that father is dependent on his minor child or has not been earning himself. Therefore, the only dependent will be mother of deceased and shall be entitled for entire compensation. As such, it is directed that a total compensation of **Rs.37,63,682/-** be given alongwith simple interest @7.5% from date of filing of DAR i.e. 08.07.2025 till realization. Out of the total compensation, Rs.7,63,682/- be released in the bank account of mother namely Rukmini Devi in her bank account. Remaining Rs.30,00,000/- with proportionate interest be kept in 100 monthly equated fixed deposit to be released monthly to the Rukmini Devi in her bank account.

Award amount shall be deposited by respondent insurance company in Account No. 42709452600 of MACT South West Dwarka Courts, New Delhi, IFSC Code : SBIN0011566, MICR No. 110002483 through RTGS/NEFT/IMPS within 30 days of the award as per section 168(3) of M.V. Act under intimation to the Nazir of this court with proof of notice to the claimant/injured and his Counsel.

As and when the claimant provides her MACT bank account details alongwith Aadhar card and Pancard, the bank shall act to release the amount.

In view of the aforesaid, the present case is disposed off. A copy of this order be given to the parties and be also sent to the bank.
