20.07.2026		The application for bail has been filed on behalf of petitioners namely (1) Kunal Munda @ Kunal Kumar, and (2) Sagar Kumar Nayak, who are accused in relation to Gonda P.S. Case No. 55/2026, registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109(1), 352, 351(2) &(3), 3(5) of the Baratiya Nyaya Sanhita is taken up for hearing. Heard learned counsel for petitioners and learned P.P for the State. The prosecution case, as per the written report of informant Manish Kumar, in short, is that on 26.04.26 at about 6.30 pm when informant went to Gandhinagar to work in Catering, during the period, accused Sagar Nayak and his two friends namely Kunal Munda and Himanshu Jaiswal started abusing him and upon raising objection by informant, they dragged him to back side and assaulted him by means of fists and slaps and during course of occurrence, they inflicted Knife/used for pilling vegetable blow on the back of informant, causing deep cut in his back. It is also alleged that he was brought to Gandhinagar Hospital and from there he was referred to RIMS, Ranchi and after treatment he made complaint. Accordingly, F.I.R is lodged. It has been submitted by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners that these petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that the petitioners have no any concern with the alleged occurrence rather as per allegation petitioners were only present there. It is also submitted that general and omnibus allegations have been made against these petitioners. It is also submitted that there is no any ingredient to make out offence under Sections 109(1) and 118(1) of the BNS. It is also submitted that co-accused against whom allegation are mainly made has already been admitted to bail vide BP No. 526/2026 dated 22.05.2026 and these petitioners have no any criminal antecedent. Hence petitioners may be enlarged on bail. Learned Public Prosecutor for the State opposed the prayer for bail.	

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<u>Contd...2</u> 20.07.2026	In view of the submissions of the parties as well as going through material collected in the record, it appears that there is dispute between co-accused and informant, which is directly related to one co-accused namely Himanshu Jaiswal, who has been admitted to bail vide BP No. 526/2026 dated 22.05.2026. It also appears from the record that informant was discharged on the same date from the hospital and then instant case has been instituted. There is no any direct or specific allegations against these petitioners. It is also said that petitioners are having no criminal antecedent. There requires no custodial interrogation and the petitioners are ready to co-operate in the investigation. So, in the light of all the above discussed facts, I am inclined to allow the application for anticipatory bail. Accordingly, petitioners in the event of arrest or surrender before the Court below within two weeks from today, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000=00 with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court below subject to the condition as laid down under Section 482 of the BNSS, subject to the condition that petitioners shall co-operate in the investigation, failing which I.O is at liberty to move before the Court below for cancellation of bail.
