The Counsel for Applicant/Accused seeks extension interim bail for 45 days on the ground of medical condition of elder son of the applicant/accused. It is submitted that the surgery regarding the nose bleeding of the elder son of the applicant/accused is still pending and the elder son of the applicant-accused has undergone toe surgery. During the course of arguments, it is submitted that the interim bail of applicant-accused be extended as the Applicant-Accused is required to take care of his elder son during the said surgery and there is no one to take care of him.

The IO has today verified the medical documents of the elder son of the applicant/accused and submitted that the surgery is scheduled for 01.11.2025 and the elder son of applicant/accused requires 2-3 days postoperative care and further care of 7 days.

The IO submits that he himself gone to the concerned department of the hospital and has verified from the concerned doctors and thereafter, file his report.

With respect to the medical condition of the elder son of the applicant/accused the counsel for the complainant has vehemently opposed the present application on the ground that these are delay tactics and there is no reason why the elder son of Applicant/accused was not immediately operated for his complaint of nasal bleeding on as was urged vide the earlier application. It is submitted that the

complainant is ready to bear the expenses of the surgery and take care of the elder son of the applicant/accused and the present application be dismissed.

Looking at the medical report of the elder son fo the applicant/accused and the submission of IO, that the elder son of Applicant/Accused continues to be hospitalized and the surgery of elder son of applicant/accused is scheduled on 01.11.2025, the interim bail application of applicant/accused is hereby extended till 06.11.2025 on similar terms and conditions as imposed vide order dated 17.10.2025. The applicant/accused shall surrender on 07.11.2025 before 5.00 PM before concerned Jail Superintendent.

It is made clear that no further extension will be granted to the applicant/accused.

Copy of this order be sent to concerned Superintendent Jail physically as well as through e-mail for information/compliance. Copy of this order be also given dasti to the counsel for the applicant/accused, as prayed.

Accordingly, the present application moved on behalf of the applicant/accused stands disposed of.

At this stage, counsel for applicant/accused seeks permission to sign the affidavit by applicant/accused before the jail authorities.

Heard. Same is allowed.

Copy of this order be sent to concerned Jail Superintendent and SHO concerned for necessary information and compliance.
