Evidence by way of affidavit of Mr. Anil Mandal filed.

The same is taken on record.

Statement of CW-1 Mr. Ashutosh Kumar and CW-2 Mr. Anil Mandal recorded in pre-summoning evidence in support of the complaint under Section 135/138 of the Electricity Act, 2003 alleging the commission of direct theft of electricity.

CW-1 Mr. Ashutosh Kumar is working as an Authorized Representative with the complainant company and he has proved the GPA in his favour.

CW-2 Mr. Anil Mandal is working as Technician with the Complainant company. He was member of the raiding team which inspected the premises of the accused and he has proved the documents Ex. CW-2/1 to Ex. CW-2/8.

At the time of joint inspection by the raiding team of the complainant, the accused was found indulging in theft of electricity through the tampered meter which was installed in his name. Two illegal shunts wires were found to be connected between phase to phase and neutral to neutral terminal of the said meter. The accused is alleged to have caused wrongful loss to the complainant and wrongful gain to himself.

Thus, there are sufficient grounds to proceed against the accused for the offence punishable under Section 135/138 of the Electricity Act, 2003.

Accordingly, the accused be summoned on filing of PF for 17.09.2026. The process be executed through the concerned SHO.
