	28.04.2025	<u>ORDER</u> No step filed by plaintiff side. Defendant nos. 8, 3, 10 and 30 are represented. The record was put up before me. It is at the stage of plaintiff evidence. No one turned up on calls. Perused the case record. Upon perusal, it transpires that the suit was filed on 18.05.2001, and was admitted. On 21.07.2023, issues were framed and the suit was posted for Plaintiff evidence. After 3 dates passed, the plaintiff filed list of witnesses on 12.10.2023. Still, as the plaintiff was not producing witnesses, on 29.01.2024, the plaintiff was granted three dates to produce witnesses. Today is the tenth date since that order, fixed for plaintiff to produce evidence, but they did not take any step despite passage of a considerable time. The plaintiff has neither been filing any step, nor appearing on call nor producing evidence. Thus, a considerable time has elapsed but plaintiff is not pursuing the suit in a time-bound manner. This shows the plaintiff has lost interest in this suit. Also, no evidence is available on record to proceed with judgment. Thus, the suit is hereby <u>dismissed</u> under <u>Order IX, Rule 8</u>, CPC.
