IO Inspector Satyender Dhull was directed to be present before the Court on last date of hearing alongwith laptop to play the CD regarding the alleged conversation between the witness Shalini and accused Sumit during the deposition of PW Shalini. The IO was present in the Court till 11:30 am, however, when the matter was called up for deposition of witness PW-16 Shalini at 12:30 pm, this Court was informed that IO had left the Court for Rohini Court without informing. It is rather surprising that when the IO was aware that his assistance was required during the deposition of material witness Shalini to play the CD, he left without informing the Court before the matter was called out for hearing. Further, when the Court staff again tried to contact the IO, his mobile phone has been found switched off.

Counsel for the accused Sumit submits that IO has tutored the witness Shalini outside the Court premises. On query, the witness submits that IO has told her to depose in what manner.

Issue bailable warrants against the IO Inspector Satyender Dhull, in the sum of Rs. 1,000/- through DCP concerned for next date of hearing.

PW-16 Shalini is discharged unexamined for today and bound down for next date of hearing.

Also issue summons to IO and MHC(M) concerned to produce the case property, if any, on next date of hearing.

Re-list the matter for remaining prosecution evidence on 03.10.2024.
