Arguments on the point of charge heard. Record perused.

Ld. defence counsel has argued that accused has been falsely implicated in this case after planting alleged contraband. He further submits that since the FSL result is still awaited and it may take a considerable time in filing the FSL result, the Court may proceed in framing of charge as per law.

Ld. Addl. PP for State has argued that at this stage, there is enough evidence against the accused for framing of charge for the chargesheet ed offence, therefore, the charge may be framed under relevant provisions of law.

After hearing both sides and in view of statements of witnesses and material available on record, this Court is of the considered view that a prima facie case under section 20(B)(ii)(b) of NDPS Act is made out against the accused. Accordingly, charge framed, to which the accused pleaded not guilty and claimed trial.

Now to come up for PE on 13.12.2023. Witnesses no.1, 10, IO and MHC(M) be summoned for next date of hearing.
