O R D E R:

1. The present bail application has been filed by above named
accused/applicant Ranjodh Singh alias Yodha under section 438 Cr.P.C.,
in FIR No. 135 Dated 29.11.2020, under section 307, 295-A, 324, 323,
506, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Ghall Khurd.

2. Brief facts of the case are that present FIR has been registered against the accused/applicant and others on the basis of statement of complainant Sukhjinder Singh son of Gurdev Singh. Complainant states that he had sold one vehicle make Chhota Hathi bearing No. PB-10-EH-0712 to accused Arshdeep Singh @ Arsh son of Rachhpal Singh, who paid Rs. 20,000/- to the complainant and promised to pay the remaining amount within three days and took away the vehicle but despite passing of a period of more than a week, he had not paid any amount and when ever the complainant contacts him on mobile phone, he kept on saying that he will pay the remaining amount shortly and later on he started ignoring the phone calls of complainant. On 28.11.2020, complainant alongwith his father went to the house of accused Arshdeep Singh alias Arsh for demanding his money, where father of accused Arshdeep Singh told the complainant that accused Arshdeep Singh is not present in the house. Thereafter complainant alongwith his father were coming back and on the way he received a phone call on his mobile from Ranjodh Singh alias Yodha, who told the complainant that he is brother of accused Arshdeep Singh and they both are present at Satkartar Denting Painting workshop near HDFC Bank Mudki and asked the complainant to

come and get his remaining amount. Upon this, complainant and his father went to the said workshop, where accused Ranjodh Singh @ Yodha loaded with kapa, Arshdeep Singh alias Arsh loaded with baseball, Satta empty handed and 8/9 unknown persons loaded with sharp edged weapons came out of the shop and immediately Arshdeep Singh alias Arsh raised lalkara to catch the complainant and his father and to teach a lesson for demanding money. Thereafter accused Satta caught the complainant from behind and accused Arshdeep Singh gave a baseball blow with intention to kill the complainant, which hit on back side of his right shoulder, then accused Ranjodh Singh @ Yodha gave kapa blow with full force on head of the complainant with intention to kill, which hit above his right ear in his head and blood oozed out and complainant fell on the ground. Then all the accused persons caught the complainant from beard and hairs and started pulling and dragging and also put soil in his beard and when father of complainant tried to rescue, he was also given slaps and removed his turban and also disgraced his beard. In the mean time, Baldev Sikngh and Balraj Singh who were passing by came there and rescued the complainant and his father. Thereafter father of the complainant with the help of passers by got him admitted in Guru Gobind

Singh Medical College, Faridkot. Accordingly, FIR has been registered and apprehending his arrest, accused/applicant has filed the present bail application.

3. Notice of the bail application has been issued to the State. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State has appeared. Record has been produced.

4. Learned counsel for the accused/applicant submits that accused/applicant has been falsely implicated in this case and infact complainant was having a grudge with the brother of accused/applicant as there was some money dispute between them. Further submits that it is no where mentioned in the FIR that for how much money the deal regarding sale of vehicle was finalized and that complainant is having good political connections and present FIR has been registered only to extort money from the accused/applicant. Further submits that accused/applicant is ready to join the investigation. Thus, prays that the present bail application be allowed.

5. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State submits that accused/applicant is specifically named in the FIR and there is specific attribution qua to the present accused/applicant regarding giving

kapa blow on the head of complainant. Further submits that complainant is still not in stable condition and his entire lower portion is not in working condition. Thus, prays that bail application be dismissed.

6. After hearing learned counsel for the accused/applicant and learned APP for the State and perusal of the record, it reflects that the complainant has alleged that the present accused/applicant is the main accused, who was loaded with kappa and has caused injury on the head of complainant with his kappa but said kappa has hit just above the right ear of complainant. Further learned Additional Public Prosecutor for State has specifically raised the argument that the complainant is still not in stable condition and his entire lower portion is not in working condition. Thus, taking into consideration the injuries on the person of complainant being attracted to the present accused/applicant, this court is of the considered opinion that no ground is made out to grant extra ordinary concession of anticipatory bail to the accused/applicant. Accordingly, without commenting anything on merits of the case, present bail application is dismissed being without merits. File be consigned to the record room.
