Complainant : State represented by the Sub Inspector of Police, Fort Police Station in Crime No.1375/22. (By APP Gr-II, Smt. Sujakumari.K)

Accused : Vijayamma, D/o Pooyappa Nadar, Aswathi Bhavan, Plangottumugal, Santhumoola, Potta Village, 10th ward, Potta.

Offence : U/ss.118(i) of Kerala Police Act & S.6 r/w S.24 of Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade & Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) Act COTPA.

Plea : Guilty

Finding : Guilty

Sentence : Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of ₹.500/-for the offences u/ss.118(i) of Kerala Police Act & S.6 r/w S.24 of Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade & Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) Act COTPA and in default; to undergo simple imprisonment for 5 days.

This case having been heard today, the court passed the following:-

J U D G M E N T

1. Accused stands charged with the offence punishable u/ss.118(i) of Kerala Police Act & S.6 r/w S.24 of Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade & Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) Act COTPA.
2. Accused is present. Requirement u/s.207 Cr.PC was complied with and after hearing both sides, charge was framed for the offence aforesaid, read over and explained to the accused to which she pleaded guilty. I accept the plea since I am convinced of its genuineness and that the same is made voluntarily. Hence, I find the accused is guilty of the offences punishable u/ss.118(i) of Kerala Police Act & S.6 r/w S.24 of Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade & Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) Act COTPA and convicted her u/s.248(2) of Cr.PC. Heard on the question of sentence to which the accused pleaded for leniency. Accordingly, the accused is sentenced to pay a fine of ₹.500/-for the offences u/ss.118(i) of Kerala Police Act & S.6 r/w S.24 of Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade & Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) Act COTPA and in default; to undergo simple imprisonment for 5 days.
