This petition came before this court today for final hearing. Upon perusal of records and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court delivers the following....

**ORDER.**

The petition has been filed u/s 483(1)(b) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS) to relax the bail condition already imposed vide order in CrI.M.P.No.2476/2026.

Reply received. Heard both sides. FIR was registered against the petitioner in Cr.No.1117/2021 U/S.394 r/w 397 of IPC. Originally, a condition was imposed that the petitioner/accused should report before this Court on all working days at 10.00 A.M until further orders. The petitioner is complying the condition for 26 days mentioned in this petition. The respondent/police submitted reply, that the petitioner is complying the condition for 37 days and the petitioner is not complied the condition for six days. Considering the same and the petitioner since complied the condition for 37 days. The condition imposed on him that he shall appear and sign before this court is totally relaxed.

Accordingly this petition is allowed.
