Ld. Counsel Mr. B. Saha has filed a hand-sketch map of the suit and its adjacent areas, through firisti, after serving copy.

Heard the submissions of both sides at length.

In this suit the main dispute pertains to the right to use of the suit pathway (Schedule-A) by the plaintiff-petitioners and both parties have placed on record two private layout maps showing different positioning of the pathway. The suit pathway is not displayed in any Govt. Survey Map and its positioning is to be ascertained from the rival deeds of the parties. Due to this reason, without having any local investigation of the suit land and ascertainment of the suit pathway by a team of Govt. Revenue Officers, the court is not in a position to grant the temporary injunction as prayed for in the application.

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Situated thus, the present injunction application is disposed of with a direction to both parties to maintain status quo over the suit of pathway till the final disposal of the main suit TS 98 of 2025 or till the present order is vacated due to any subsequent development, whichever is earlier.

It is further directed that the rival parties shall either jointly or severally apply for revenue demarcation of the suit pathway along with preparation of a sketch-map of the same by filing appropriate application in the proceeding of TS 98 of 2025 immediately.

The ex-parte ad-interim order dated 12.06.2025 stands modified to the extent as mentioned herein above.

With these observations and directions, the present application stands disposed of on contest.
